

*The undersigned teachers of Music Higher Education Institutions from CEI countries, meeting in Trieste for the workshop on "CEI Music Higher Education Network" (26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> October, 2016); undertake to make their respective bodies approve the following Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)*

### **Memorandum of Understanding**

The Music Academies, the Music Conservatories, the Music University Faculties from the constituency of the Central European Initiative

- sharing the firm belief that Music is universal language that overcomes national boundaries;
- acknowledging the importance of the European dimension of Music Higher Education,
- integrating in a single European framework music higher educational institutions from EU countries and from still non-member countries;
- having assessed how transnational networking is a guarantee for developing and delivering high quality standards to the benefit of the Music Higher Education Systems;
- convinced that an international cooperation network must be multi-folding;
- considering that the dissemination of common values and achievements is useful, also in view of feeding evidence-based decision making by the relevant national authorities;
- having agreed on all what above;

**undertake to create the Central European Music Academies Network with the acronym CEMAN to implement new initiatives and pursue additional common goals through cooperation in the following fields:**

- mobility of students, teachers and staff especially in the framework of EU mobility programmes and other regional programmes like CEEPUS;
- exchange of good educational and administrative practices;
- promotion of different musical and cultural traditions;
- design and realization of joint artistic productions, research in the field of music and arts;
- support partners fundraising and participation to the calls of relevant EU and international programmes, making the most of the added value of consolidated networks;
